FLORIDA STATE TOPS FLORIDA GULF COAST; TO MEET XAVIER IN NCAA ROUND OF 32

Florida State, which won its 26th game of the season with its 86-80 win over Florida Gulf Coast on Thursday night in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, plays 11th seeded Xavier in the NCAA Tournament round of 32 on Saturday, March 18, 2017 at 6:10 p.m. at the Amway Center in Orlando, Fla. The Seminoles and Musketeers will meet for the first time in nearly 60 years as the two last played on February 4, 1958 in a regular season game won by Xavier. The Seminoles' victory over Florida Gulf Coast was their first NCAA Tournament victory since 2012 and sent them to the round of 32 for the second consecutive appearance in the event. Florida State has now won three consecutive NCAA Tournament games that have been played in the state of Florida – and the City of Orlando – with two wins at the Orlando Arena during the 1993 NCAA Southeast Regional. In topping Florida Gulf Coast on Thursday night, the Seminoles scored 86 points – its most in an NCAA Tournament game since defeating Texas Christian (96-87) in the first round of the 1998 NCAA Tournament.

SEMINOLES ON THE VERGE OF TYING SCHOOL RECORD FOR VICTORIES

Florida State enters Saturday's game against Xavier looking to win its school record tying 27th game of the season. The Seminoles' 26 victories are tied for the second most in school history and is only one win away from tying the school record for wins in a single season. Florida State's 1971-72 team won a school record 27 games in advancing to the championship game of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history.

FLORIDA STATE LEADS THE NATION IN DUNKS

With nine dunks in its victory over Florida Gulf Coast on Thursday, the Seminoles ran their season-long total of dunks to 180 – and continue to rank as the national leaders in that offensive category. Kentucky (who played on Friday) began its game against Northern Kentucky ranked second nationally with 164. Florida Gulf Coast finished its season ranked third with 159 dunks.

FLORIDA STATE SHOOTS EXCEEDINGLY WELL IN WIN OVER FGCU

Florida State shot .556 from the field in scoring 86 points in its victory over Florida Gulf Coast in the first round of the 2017 NCAA Tournament. The Seminoles shot .581 percent in the first half (18 of 31) and .522 percent in the second half (12 of 23) to mark the second consecutive game and 14th time this season the Seminoles have shot better than 50 percent from the field in a game.

ISAAC PLAYS COMPLETE GAME IN WIN OVER FGCU

Freshman phenom Jonathan Isaac scored 17 points, pulled down 10 rebounds, was credited with five assists, three blocked shots and two steals in 34 minutes played. His points and rebounds marked his eighth career double double (and second of the postseason) and his five assists rank as a career high. Isaac also totaled a double double in his first career ACC Tournament game (11 points and 12 rebounds) and enters Saturday's game against Xavier with two double doubles in his last three games.

ISAAC IN HIS LAST THREE GAMES

Freshman phenom Jonathan Isaac is averaging 11.0 points (33 total points) and 12.3 rebounds (37 total rebounds) in his last three games – all against teams that played in the NCAA Tournament (12 points and 12 rebounds against Virginia Tech, five points and 15 rebounds against Notre Dame and 17 points and 10 rebounds against Florida Gulf Coast).

LOOK FOR FLORIDA STATE TO...

...Defeat Xavier and advance to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament for the fifth time in school history and for the first time since 2011;

...Defeat Xavier and win its fourth consecutive NCAA Tournament game played in the state of Florida. The Seminoles won two games during the 1993 NCAA Tournament at the Orlando Arena with victories over Evansville and Tulane on its way to the Elite Eight;

FLORIDA STATE'S WIN TOTAL IN THE LAST 11 YEARS

Florida State is the third winningest program in the ACC in the last 11 years (since the start of the 2005-06 season) in total games played as a member of the ACC with 254 wins. The Seminoles average 21.2 wins per season with records of 20-10 (2005-06), 22-13 (2006-07), 19-15 (2007-08), 25-10 (2008-09), 22-10 (2009-10), 23-11 (2010-11), 25-10 (2011-12), 18-16 (2012-13), 22-14 (2013-14), 17-16 (2014-15), 20-14 (2015-16) and 26-8 (2016-17).

BACON SCORES 25 IN WIN OVER FLORIDA GULF COAST

All-American candidate Dwayne Bacon scored 25 points in Florida State's victory over Florida Gulf Coast – the fourth time this season and sixth time in his career that he has scored at least 25 points. He has now scored a single-season career 583 and enters Saturday's game against Xavier averaging a career-high 17.1 points per game. Bacon is ranked 34th in school history in career scoring and is the Seminoles' all-time leading sophomore scorer. Bob Sura, the only other Florida State player to reach the 1,000 career point mark as a sophomore, totaled 1,055 points in his first two seasons as a Seminole.

DWAYNE BACON IN HIS LAST SEVEN GAMES

Sophomore Dwayne Bacon has scored 130 points, is averaging 18.6 points per game, is shooting .789 from the free throw line (30 of 38), and has totaled 12 assists and seven steals in the last seven games dating to a 20-point scoring effort in Florida State's victory over Boston College on February 20. He averaged 17.5 points and 8.5 rebounds in Florida State's two games in the 2017 ACC Tournament.

MANN GETS THE SEMINOLES GOING

Sophomore forward Terance Mann scored 11 points – including Florida State's first eight points of the second half to give his team a commanding 48-40 lead with 17:18 remaining to be played. It marked the career-high 15th time that he has scored in double figures as a sophomore – as compared to his double figure scoring total of three games as a freshman. The Seminoles led by as many as 12 following his scoring outburst that included a lay-up, a dunk and four free throws that helped the Seminoles go from two points up to eight points up in a span of 1:53.

FLORIDA STATE BLOCKS NINE SHOTS IN NCAA TOURNAMENT WIN OVER FGCU

With three players – Chris Koumadje (four), Jonathan Isaac (three) and Michael Ojo (two) accounting for all of their blocked shots, the Seminoles blocked nine shots in their victory over Florida Gulf Coast. It marked the second time this season the Seminoles totaled nine or more blocked shots (they blocked a season-high 11 in their win over Southern Miss on December 6) and brought their season total to 177 (5.2 bpg).

ISAAC ADDS TO TEAM-LEADING BLOCK TOTAL

Freshman phenom Jonathon Isaac blocked three shots in Florida State's victory over Florida Gulf Coast to bring his season total to 48 (1.5 bpg). He has now blocked multiple shots in 14 different games this season with three or more coming in four different games with his career-high of seven coming in Florida State's victory over Notre Dame on January 18 in Tallahassee. Isaac's 38 blocked shots rank as the third highest total by a freshman in school history. Corey Louis blocked a Seminole freshman record 74 shots during the 1994-95 season.

NOTING KOUMADJE'S NIGHT AGAINST FGCU

Sophomore center Chris Koumadje scored seven points (his most since scoring eight in the Seminoles' win over George Washington on December 4), grabbed three rebounds (his most since pulling down three in the Seminoles' victory over Clemson on February 25), tied his career-high with four blocked shots, earned a career-high tying two steals (his third multiple steal game of his career) and played a career-high 21 minutes (his most since playing 20 in Florida State's win over Nicholls State on December 8).

KOUMADJE BLOCKS FOUR SHOTS IN WIN OVER EAGLES

Sophomore Chris Koumadje tied his career-high with four blocked shots in Florida State's victory over Florida Gulf Coast. It marked the second time this season he blocked four shots as he also sent back four shots in Florida State's victory over Illinois on November 25. Koumadje enters Saturday's game against Xavier with a single-season career-high 40 blocked shots and 59 for his 60 game career – an average of nearly one blocked shot in each game of his career.

NEXT UP FOR RATHAN-MAYES ON 3-POINT FIELD GOALS MADE LIST – IS HIS DAD

Junior Xavier Rathan-Mayes enters Saturday's game against Xavier ranked 13th in school history with 126 career 3-point field goals made. He is chasing his father, Tharon, who made 128 career 3-point shots as a Seminole for 12th place on Florida State's all-time 3-point field goals made record list.

RATHAN-MAYES ALSO CHASING HIS DAD ON THE SEMINOLES' ALL-TIME SCORING LIST

Junior Xavier Rathan-Mayes enters Saturday's game against Xavier ranked 26th in school history in scoring with 1,220 points. He also needs only 41 points to move into 22nd place in scoring with 1,261 points – surpassing his father, Tharon.

FLORIDA STATE VS. XAVIER – THE LAST MEETING

Florida State Hall of Famer Hugh Durham scored 25 points but a 34-17 deficit at halftime was too much for Florida State to recover from as Xavier won the first meeting between the two teams, 76-60, in a game played on February 4, 1958 in Cincinnati, Ohio. The Seminoles outscored their hosts by a 43-42 margin in the second half but were unable to pull closer than eight points against Xavier which entered the game ranked 15th nationally by the International News Service. Durham (25 points), Burt Deckel (13 points) and Jim Liteky (12 points) all scored in double figures for the Seminoles.

FLORIDA STATE AGAINST THE BIG EAST

Florida State will face its first Big East opponent since defeating DePaul, 83-67, in the final round of the Paradise Jam on November 21, 2015. In facing Xavier on Saturday, the Seminoles will play a Big East opponent for the fourth consecutive season (DePaul in 2015-16, Providence in 2014-15 and Georgetown in the NIT in 2013-14). Seminole head coach Leonard Hamilton was named the 1995 and 1999 Big East Coach of the Year at the University of Miami. Hamilton is the only coach to be named the ACC Coach of the Year AND the Big East Coach of the Year twice in both leagues. Hamilton, the winningest coach at both Florida State and Miami, coached Miami as members of the Big East from the 1991-92 season through the 1999-00 season. Xavier joined the Big East for the 2013-14 season.
